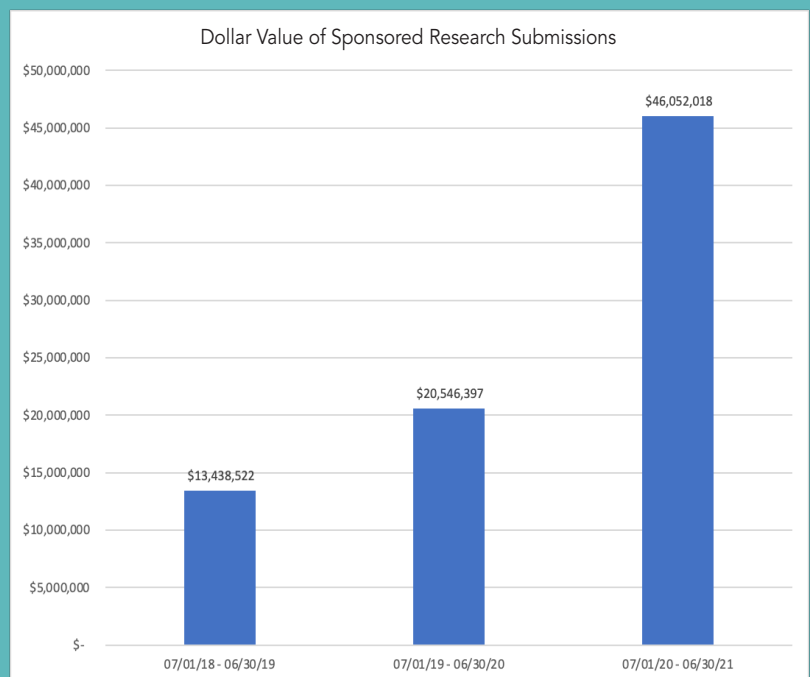

School of Public Affairs

- The Master of Public Administration program was re-accredited by the Network of Schools of Public Policy, Affairs, and Administration (NASPAA) for a four-year period (September 1, 2018 - August 31, 2022).

School of Science, Engineering, and Technology

- All School of Science, Engineering, and Technology undergraduate engineering and engineering technology programs are accredited by ABET. Engineering programs are evaluated through the Engineering Accreditation Commission (EAC) of ABET and engineering technology programs are evaluated through the Engineering Technology Accreditation Commission (ETAC) of ABET. 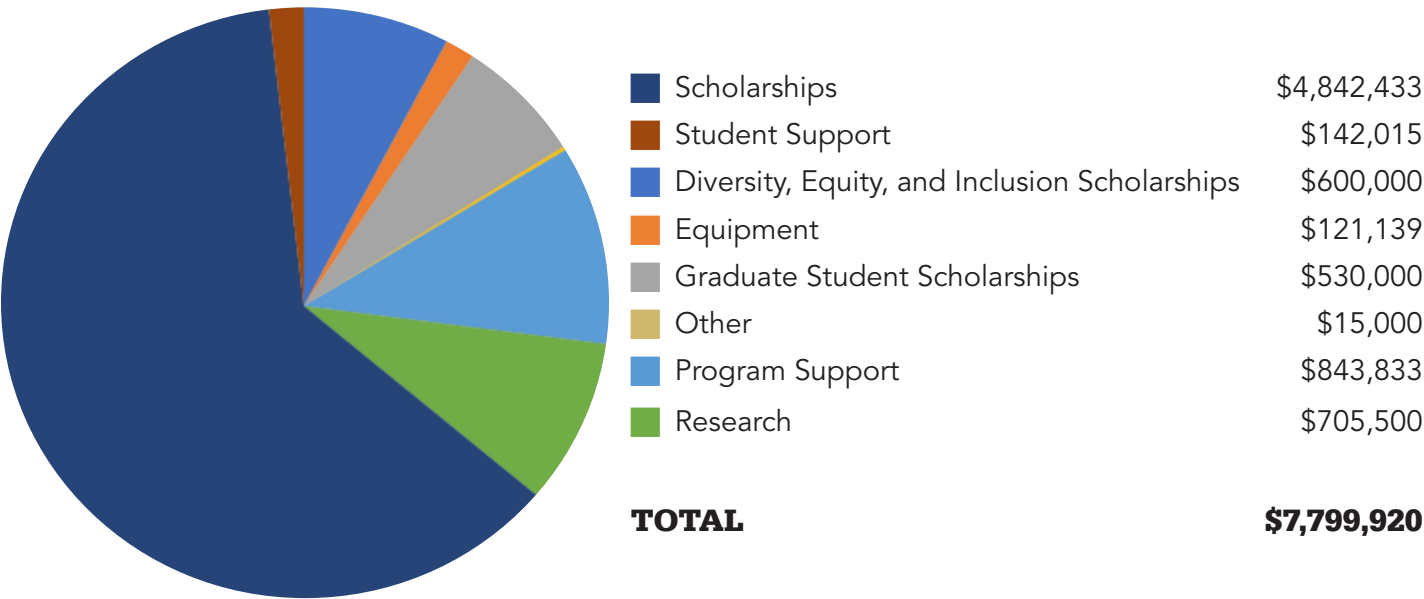
