

THE POOL

The Aquatics Center swimming pool is handicap accessible and designed to permit maximum use for lap swimming, water fitness programs, swimming lessons, and leisure. The 9,000-square-foot facility is 37 x 75 feet and provides a six-lane lap pool with depths ranging from four feet to six feet, three inches. The water temperature is maintained between 83-84 degrees.



LOCKER ROOM FACILITIES

Lockers and locks may be reserved by students enrolled in kinesiology classes. Community members may use lockers on a daily basis only and must provide their own lock. Children under the age of five may accompany a parent of the opposite gender into the locker room. Children five and up must use the gender-appropriate locker room or make use of the single restroom on the pool deck.

PARKING ON CAMPUS

A fee of \$1/day or \$40/year is charged for parking on campus. Yearly permits may be purchased at the Vehicle Registration Office. For information, call 717-948-6006.

LAP/OPEN SWIM

For adults, 18 years and older:
Minimum four lanes circle swim
two lanes open

RECREATIONAL LAP/OPEN SWIM

For adults and children:

Minimum three lanes circle swim
three lanes open
(Parents must attend and supervise
their child at all times.)

Children may use facilities at these times only:

September - April

Saturday - 1:00-5:00 p.m.
Sunday - 12:00-4:00 p.m.

May - August

Monday-Friday - 2:00-4:00 p.m.
Saturday and Sunday - Closed
