<u>**Purpose</u>**: The purpose of this scholarship shall be to provide recognition and financial assistance to outstanding undergraduate and/or graduate students enrolled or planning to enroll in the Health Administration degree program, or successor degree program at Penn State Harrisburg.</u>

Eligibility: Consideration for this scholarship shall be given to undergraduate and/or graduate students enrolled or planning to enroll in the Health Administration degree program, or successor degree program, at Penn State Harrisburg who have achieved superior academic records (as demonstrated by a grade point average of at least 3.5 on a scale of 4.0) or who manifest promise of outstanding academic success.

<u>Term</u>: The fellowship will include a tuition scholarship. The number and amount of the awards are based on the amount of the available funds. This scholarship is applicable for the upcoming <u>Fall 2019 - Spring 2020</u> academic year only. Scholarships are not transferable to other semesters. Any remaining funds revert back to the scholarship fund. Funding is applied directly to the awardee's 2019-20 PSU tuition account.
