Integrated Undergraduate-Graduate Program

WHAT IS IT? A 5-year (10-semester) program for exceptional students who want to graduate with a B.S. in Civil Engineering and a M. Eng. in Environmental Engineering.

WHY SHOULD I APPLY? Traditionally, the BS CE requires 130 credits and a M. Eng. ENVE requires 30 credits, for a total of 160 credits. Students in the IUG program need only 150 credits for graduation with two degrees (10 credits double count).

WHEN WILL I APPLY? During my 6th semester of the Civil Engineering Recommended Academic Plan.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Enrolled in the Penn State Harrisburg Civil Engineering Program
- 2) GPA of 3.3 in MATH, CHEM, C E, and ENVE courses (taken to date)
- 3) Overall 3.0 GPA
- 4) Completed a minimum of 82 credits
- 5) Be enrolled in or have completed C E 335, 336, 360, and 370
- 6) Accepted into the Graduate Program
