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### **INFORMATION FOR LIFEGUARD APPLICANTS**



#### **ELIGIBILITY**

We will review your application materials for the following requirements:

- Age 16
- Legal status Able to legally work in the United States. Must provide documentation to the Human Resources Office upon hiring.
- Certification All lifeguards must be certified in Lifeguard Training, First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer. (Original certificates must be provided. Copies of certifications are not accepted. Current certification is a condition of employment for lifeguards.)
- Background checks All prospective employees must undergo a criminal background check. The Human Resources Office determines eligibility based on results.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS**

Prior to being considered for employment, you must attend a scheduled pre-employment skill evaluation. The following skills will be evaluated:

- 300-yard prerequisite swim freestyle/front crawl breaststroke
- · Brick retrieval
- Tread water for three minutes
- Active victim
- Submerged victim
- In-line stabilization
- CPR/AED bring your own mask
- · Written test

#### **INTERVIEWS**

We are looking for highly motivated individuals who are attentive to the patrons and capable of recognizing hazards and performing rescues when needed. Lifeguarding is a serious job and a large responsibility for each person utilizing the Aquatics Center. We provide training to our lifeguards to better prepare you to handle emergencies in our facility.

#### HIRING

Newly hired lifeguards are expected to work at least one shift per week. We are looking for individuals with flexible schedules.

#### **TRAINING**

Penn State lifeguards participate in pre-service and in-service training to ensure response and preparedness in an emergency.

Training is a requirement of the job! Lifeguards who fail to attend trainings will be removed from the schedule or dismissed. In-service training is typically held on Sunday evenings with a monthly lunch-time meeting.

#### **SCHEDULING**

Scheduling is completed each semester based on seniority. Everyone is guaranteed one shift per week. The shifts are split throughout the day. This makes it easy to schedule around classes!

Additional shifts are available when a guard needs coverage for a shift. Flexibility is important.

#### **SWIMMING LESSON INSTRUCTORS**

Individuals are needed to teach lessons to participants of all ages. Instructors must be able to plan lessons, effectively instruct participants, and evaluate participants according to Penn State Harrisburg Aquatics Center's standards and the standards of the American Red Cross. Preferred skills: American Red Cross (or comparable organization) Water Safety Instructor (WSI) or Lifeguard Certification, previous experience teaching swimming, and strong swimming skills.



- Lifeguards train throughout the semester to maintain their skills to perform when an emergency occurs.
- We review our EAP (Emergency Action Plan) throughout training.
- Three hours per month training, plus weekly 500-yard swims and CPR review.
- Striving to increase response time through frequent training and building confidence to be prepared for an emergency situation.
- Team building and customer service training add to the lifeguarding experience.
